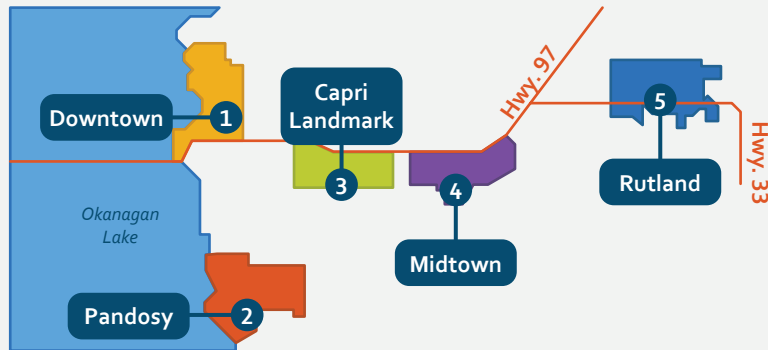


Kelowna's five Urban Centres are the largest hubs for activity in the city and are a critical component of a growing community.

Compact communities



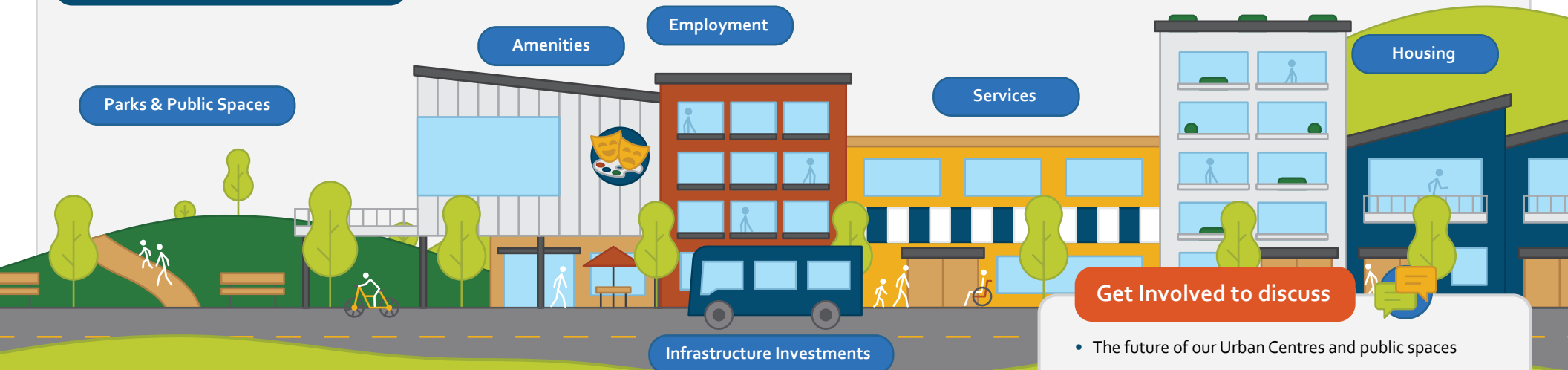
Compact, complete communities are healthier and enjoy a higher quality of life. The environmental impact of growth in these communities is lower than their suburban counterparts, and their long-term financial sustainability is more secure.

Today approximately 20,000 people live in our Urban Centres. By 2040 that number will nearly double to 38,000
